Title: Street name request

Purpose of Report

For members to consider a request from EDDC for street names on the new Taylor Wimpey site.

Recommendation:

Honiton Town Council **RESOLVES** names be put forward to the officers for street names on the new Taylor Wimpey Site and that they be listed in order of preference and sent to EDDC.

Report

- 1. The council has been approached by EDDC with names put forward by Taylor Wimpey that they believe reflect the environment and sustainability.
- 2. The names being suggested are:
 - a. Rose Way
 - b. Tulip Close
 - c. Primrose Road
 - d. Peony View
- **3.** EDDC have also suggested that alternative names that could be considered an which have been taken from Parish Tithe maps and 1842 Tithe Apportionment Transcription could include the following names:
 - a. Hill Close
 - b. Dock Close
 - c. Town Hills
 - d. Hoopernhayes
- 4. Members have also been asked to suggest names of their own that they consider acceptable and which should then be listed in order of preference. They have requested that the council provides more than 5 names in case Royal Mail has an objection to any of the names. A site plan, <u>APPENDIX 13A</u>

- 5. Attached is a form <u>APPENDIX 13B</u> for members to list their preferred names. The office will then take forms that are submitted by members and sort them into an order based upon the number of times that they are suggested by members.
- 6. Having been in touch with EDDC it has been explained that this would not be able to be brought to members until the meeting on the 9 September. They have indicated that they will a response as soon after the meeting as possible. With this in mind I would suggest that members email/hand in their forms by Thursday the 12 September.
