Dear sports club/society,

**Re: Sports meeting on Tuesday 13 August,**

As a result of the availability of funds being made available from the building of various properties in the Honiton area, the Town Council is looking for suggestions of ways in which it can assist sports and activity organisations to help with development of their activities.

There are tight guidelines in the way that the money can be used laid down by central government. Whilst Community Infrastructure Levy funds can be spent on buildings and infrastructure, this does not apply to Section 106 funds and at the moment S106 is the source of the majority of the funds.

These funds have to be spent on providing free or low-cost facilities to the community. That does therefore have implications on the types of projects that the money can be allocated to.

In order to help the Town Council look at various projects, it is intended to hold a meeting with as many sports clubs and organisations as possible. This meeting will be held 7-00 pm on **Tuesday 13 August, in the Tirard Room at the Beehive, Dowell Street.**
