Parish Paths Partnership Scheme

Honiton Town Council is part of the Parish Paths Partnership Scheme with Devon County Council. The Parish Paths Partnership Scheme (commonly known as P3) is an initiative to ensure that the rights of way network is properly maintained and well publicised. It has the support of the National Association of Local Councils and is funded by Devon County Council. The scheme is designed to encourage community involvement and the enjoyment of public rights of way.

Devon County Council is working in partnership with parish/town councils, landowners and local voluntary groups with the aim of improving the condition of the local rights of way and keeping them open and used properly.

We are therefore looking for volunteers from the local community to join a P3 Working Group whose remit will be to undertake the necessary footpath inspections and liaise with the Deputy Town Clerk in respect of the report which needs to be sent to Devon County Council by February 2020. It is proposed that the first footpath inspection will take place within the next few weeks.
