Item e. – the correspondence regarding the proposed move of the Post Office and the subsequent use of the building was discussed. The Chairman advised that the Local Planning Authority had, on three previous occasions, not complied with the Supplementary Planning Guidance (Chapel Street Development Brief).

It was noted that the Post Office is situated in the primary frontage of the town centre shopping area although its current planning use class is not known. It was agreed to request that the Chamber of Commerce speak to the owner of the Post Office building to try to ascertain its intentions for the future use of the building. It was also agreed that the Town Council would promote and support the retention of buildings for retail use in the primary frontage of the town centre shopping area.

Item f. – the information on acquisition and appropriation of land by local councils was noted and would be retained for future reference.

Item g. – the NALC bulletin of 22 April was noted. It was further noted that the bulletin of 13 May reported that the neighbourhood right of appeal had been removed from the Housing and Planning Bill which received Royal Assent on 12 May.

Item i. – move of Halse of Honiton and redevelopment of the site – it was noted that there are likely to be various heritage issues associated with the site. It was agreed to delegate authority to Cllr Coombs, assisted by Cllr Alder, to collate information relating to the heritage aspects which could then be used for future discussions with the developer.

16/55 15/2919/FUL – Gardners Barn, land north west of Lucerhayes Farm, Honiton Bottom, Higher Brand Lane, Honiton – change of use and alteration of agricultural building to form dwelling – to receive a report on the site visit held on Friday 13th May 2016

The site visit had been attended by Cllr Sara Randall-Johnson, Mr Richard Spurway (DCC), Cllr Hopkins, Cllr Coombs and the Deputy Town Clerk. The Chairman reported that Devon County Council were of the view that the lane (Footpath 26) is wide enough for the proposed vehicle access and that the applicant should undertake drainage work and maintenance if planning permission is granted.

The Chairman further reported that the EDDC Conservation Officer's comments are now available, with the recommendation that the proposal is not acceptable. The Conservation Officer's suggestions for buildings on the site to be listed as Non Designated Heritage Assets were noted and supported. The Town Council unanimously agreed to support the comments of the County Archaeologist and the Conservation Officer with regard to the heritage aspects of the site.
