### 17/383 Election of the Town Mayor and signing of the Declaration of Office

Cllr Smith made a statement and proposed that all Councillors resign in order to let the people of Honiton decide the membership of the Town Council. Cllr Smith advised that in his view it was impossible for the people of the town to see the Town Council in a positive light. The proposal was seconded by Cllr Wadsworth.

The Chairperson [Cllr Brown] adjourned the meeting for five minutes

The meeting re-convened

The Chairperson advised that Cllr Smith's proposal would be discussed but no vote would be taken as resignation was a matter for Councillors on an individual basis rather than a corporate decision.

The following points were made during the discussion:

- Councillors had been elected to serve and should not resign
- The proposal put Councillors in an impossible position
- Councillors should not abandon the electorate who have put their trust in elected members
- The Council now has an opportunity to restore unity
- The Council is conducting an investigation which needs to be concluded

Cllr Smith resigned as a Member of the Town Council.

Cllr Wadsworth resigned as a Member of the Town Council.

Mr Smith and Mrs Wadsworth left the meeting at 7.16pm

Cllr McNally proposed that Cllr Zarczynski be elected Town Mayor. This was seconded by Cllr Howard.

Cllr Hopkins proposed that Cllr Brown be elected Town Mayor. This was not seconded. Cllr Brown thanked Cllr Hopkins and advised that he would not have accepted the nomination.

#### Signed Chair

All voting voted in favour (1 abstention) and Council Zarczynski was elected Town Mayor for 2017 – 18. Cllr Zarczynski signed the Declaration of Acceptance of Office and took the Chair.

Cllr Kolek asked whether the Mayor would uphold the intention of the Employment Sub-Committee to invite Council employees to Away Days held during the year. The Mayor confirmed that employees would be invited to future Away Days.

The resignations were noted.

17/388 To confirm that the Deputy Responsible Financial Officer takes on the role of Acting Responsible Financial Officer and to agree appropriate support for this role to ensure that the Town Council meets its legal obligations regarding the financial year end March 2017

Cllr Brown proposed that the Deputy Responsible Financial Officer takes on the role of Acting Responsible Financial Officer and that the Town Council agrees to provide all appropriate support necessary for the role. This was seconded by Cllr Hopkins and **WAS RESOLVED**.

17/389 To review the terms of reference of Council Committees, Sub-Committees and Working Groups for 2017 / 18 and their delegation authorities and to resolve the following recommendations as per the Deputy Town Clerk's briefing paper:

- a. To agree the recommended changes to the committee structure and membership numbers
- b. To agree the terms of reference for each Committee, Sub-Committee or Working Group
- c. To agree delegated authority where required
- d. To appoint members to each Committee, Sub-Committee and Working Group

A briefing paper with recommendations had been circulated in advance.

a. Cllr McNally proposed that there shall be no maximum number of members of Committees, Sub-committees and Working Groups, with the exception of the Community Complex Overview Sub-Committee, the Community Engagement Forum and the Neighbourhood Plan Steering Group and that the Mayor and Deputy Mayor shall be ex officio members of all Committees and Sub-Committees. This was seconded by Cllr Hopkins and WAS RESOLVED. Cllr Brown proposed that non-members of Committees and Sub-Committees may attend and participate at meetings, including Part B items, but not vote and that where a non-member is not able to attend a meeting they may submit concerns and questions to the Chairman and Clerk of the meeting beforehand for those matters to be considered at the meeting. This was seconded by Cllr Kolek and **WAS RESOLVED.** 

Cllr Coombs proposed that a record of attendance at meetings for each council year be published at the end of the year. This was seconded by Cllr Hopkins and **WAS RESOLVED**.

- b. Cllr Brown proposed that the terms of reference of Committees, Sub-committees and Working Groups as set out in the briefing paper be approved. Cllr Taylor proposed that the terms of reference for the Policy Committee be amended to refer to version 1 of the SWAP report. The amendment was agreed. The proposal as amended was seconded by Cllr Kolek and **WAS RESOLVED**.
- c. Cllr Kolek proposed that delegated authority be approved as set out in the briefing paper. This was seconded by Cllr McNally and **WAS RESOLVED**.
