

**1. Minute 20/138 Honiton Community Complex AGM and tonight's Agenda Item  
28 HCC Proposal**

Following your expression of disappointment with the reference to HTC as a debtor to HCC, I asked the Chair of HCC for clarification at the AGM the following night. I was assured that the term 'debtor' is a conventional accounting term, and that since the Accounts in question relate to the financial year ending March 2020, it correctly described the relationship between the two bodies at that time. *I hope that the matter was clarified to the Council's satisfaction?*

I am surprised to find, once again, matters relating to HCC in Part B of the agenda. I am perfectly well aware that certain types of business *have* to be transacted in closed session, but I understand that Mrs Sexton herself was happy to see this document in Part A. *Can you tell us what sort of information her letter contained that pushed it into Part B?*

**2. Agenda items 10-12 DALC Newsletter and advice.**
