HONITON TOWN COUNCIL – HONOURED CITIZENS

- 1. The status will be awarded to people who have given exceptional and distinguished service to the Town.
- 2. The Honoured Citizen will be invited to all civic functions held by the Council, the cost to be met by the Council.
- 3. The award of Honoured Citizen will be made at a formal civic ceremony and a list of Honoured Citizens hung in the council chamber.

Procedure

- 1. A recommendation for conferment of this honour may be made by either a Member of the Council, or by any Honiton resident.
- 2. The Clerk will post a notice on the public noticeboards and advertise in the local newspaper(s) outlining the procedure.
- 3. The Councillor (unless he/she is the Mayor) or council taxpayer will write to the Mayor making the recommendation, giving reasons for the proposal.
- 4. The Mayor will arrange an informal meeting with the Council to discuss the nomination/s, to which those who have written in to make the recommendations will be invited. At that meeting they will be asked to give a supporting statement and then withdraw from the meeting. If the nominee is a Member of the Council, he/she should be excluded from the meeting. A 2/3 majority of those members attending will be required in order for the award to be approved.
- 5. It is proposed that any nominations received would be reviewed annually with a final ratification at a full town council meeting and any successful nominee(s) to be honoured at Mayor Making
