TEMPORARY PROHIBITION OF THROUGH TRAFFIC

NOTICE is hereby given that Devon County Council has made the above titled order.

On **TUESDAY 25 JULY 2023**
for a maximum of 3 days

Anticipated Finish **TUESDAY 25 JULY 2023**

Between the hours of **11:45** and **13:00**

No person shall cause or permit any vehicle to proceed on the sections of Affected Roads.

Roads affected - Between the hours of **11:45** and **12:30**

1. HIGH STREET, HONITON, BETWEEN DOWELL STREET AND NEW STREET

Roads affected - Between the hours of **12:00** and **13:00**

2. HIGH STREET, HONITON, BETWEEN DOWELL STREET AND MILL STREET

The road will only be closed for a maximum of 20 minutes at a time in each section during the times specified. Closure 2 will only take place once Closure 1 has been re-opened.

All weight restrictions on the affected roads will be suspended
