DEVON COUNTY COUNCIL hereby give **NOTICE** that:

From **MONDAY 25 MARCH 2024**
for a maximum of 5 days

Anticipated Finish **THURSDAY 28 MARCH 2024**

No person shall cause or permit any vehicle to proceed on the sections of Affected Roads.

Roads affected -

QUEEN STREET, HONITON , BETWEEN THE OLD SADDLERY AND SUMMERLAND

The alternative, signed, route for vehicles will be via - QUEEN STREET, NEW STREET, CHURCH HILL, WATERLEAT AVENUE, PINE PARK ROAD, AND VICE VERSA

The width restriction shall be suspended on the sections of Affected Roads.
