The Allotment Working Group is composed of people elected by Full Council. The Mayor and Deputy Mayor are ex Officio of this working group (with voting rights).

- 1. The Quorum for this working group shall be 3 members or 1/3 of the Working Group members.
- 2. The working group will consider all matters concerning Honiton Town Council's statute as Allotment Authority for the parish of Honiton as set down in the Small Holdings & Allotment Act 1908 s.23.
- 3. The working group will be responsible for all matters relating to:

• The sourcing of allotments and allotment gardens through either lease, and/or purchase of land(s), subject to approval of necessary funding from both the Finance Committee and Full Council, to satisfy parish demands as set down by the Small Holdings & Allotment Act 1908.

• The management of any existing, and future, council owned, and/or leased land allocated solely for the use of allotments and allotment gardens, as agreed by Full Council.

• To be the advisory body relating to the Council's allotments and allotment gardens within the parish of Honiton.

- 4. The working group is authorised to invite and co-opt other councillors not currently members of the working group and members of the public, to attend scheduled meetings of this working group for the purpose of providing advice and/or information as and when needed.
- 5. The working group will consider rents and fees for persons or groups using the allotment facilities provided and make recommendations to any appropriate Committee or Full Council.
- 6. The working group will make recommendations to any appropriate Committee and to Full Council regarding policy and strategic matters relating to all of the above.
- 7. The working group will exercise those delegated duties as the Council directs relating to the group's functions as set out above.
