## MONTHLY LOCAL PRODUCE MARKET

From Thursday 21<sup>st</sup> April Honiton has a new monthly local producers market. Building on the recent growth of the weekly Tuesday and Saturday street market and in response to feedback from residents who want to see the town developed as a hub for local food, Honiton Town Council has piloted the new

monthly market on the third Thursday of each month between April and October. The new Thursday market differs from the weekly street market as it concentrates solely on locally produced food, goods and crafts.

The Town Council has been working with producers in the local area to ensure a wide variety of products at this new market. Goods on offer include a range of food products, including meat, cakes, eggs, cider, preserves and smoked fish, together with crafts, clothing and plants.

In conjunction with the new local producers market and in order to further promote businesses within the town, the Town Council and the Chamber of Commerce have surveyed shops in Honiton which sell locally produced goods. Details of these businesses are available on the Town Council's website, www.honiton.gov.uk.

All the Honiton markets are run with no input from the parish precept. Any profit is invested in the town and provides for Christmas lights,



summer street entertainers and Charter Day. If you, or someone you know, would like to book a stall please contact the Market Manager, Tony McCollum, on 07980 922696.
