# 23/27/GOS Parish Paths Partnership (P3) Inspections 2023/24

The Deputy Clerk presented her report and advised that she was still waiting to receive the updated P3 agreement from Devon County Council. In the meantime, the inspections were currently being carried out with reports to be sent into the office. Committee **NOTED** the report.

# 23/28/GOS Himalayan Balsam and Japanese Knotweed

Cllr Cloke advised that members of the public who had expressed an interest in volunteering for the Council had confirmed that they would be willing to assist in locating the presence of Himalayan Balsam and



Japanese Knotweed. Once located the plants would need to be removed carefully and in accordance with regulations.

## 23/29/GOS The Woodland Trust – Offer of free trees/hedges

The Deputy Clerk confirmed that EDDC's Tree team had responded, and she was in discussions with them regarding possible planting locations. Cllr Cloke suggested using "what 3 words" to identify sites. The Deputy Clerk also suggested arranging site meetings.

Cllr Cloke put forward a further possible site at Old Elm Road. Whilst this is believed to be EDDC land it may be in Gittisham Parish. Committee **NOTED** the report.

## 23/30/GOS Public Spaces Protection Order for Allhallows

Cllr Cloke that PCSO Darren England and Honiton Community College should also be invited to the proposed meeting with the Rugby Club.

At this stage Members suggested an on-line survey for the public consultation.

Committee RESOLVED unanimously to invite PCSO Darren England, Honiton Rugby Club and Honiton Community College to attend an initial meeting to discuss the public consultation to support an application to vary the Public Spaces Protection Order for Allhallows.
